- Neater writing + presentation

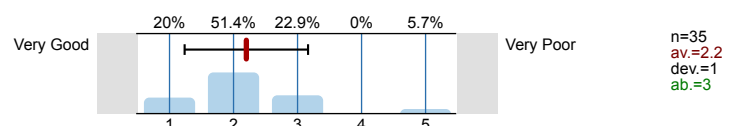
If we did not have to hand in problem sets so early

maybe slower pace.

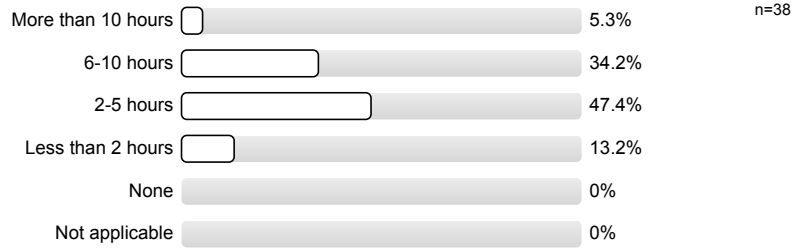
Davide knows the course material very well but the way he presents it can be done in a more organised fashion.
